 - All drivers accruing \$600.00 or more in winnings will receive a 1099 from Havasu
 95 Speedway at the end of the calendar year. The W-9 does not need to be completed by Bandoleros, Flat Karts, or the Outlaw Karts.

RULES OF CONDUCT

- 1. The Driver shall be the sole spokesperson for his/her car, car owner, pit crew, and any and all matters pertaining to an event. At all events the driver assumes responsibility for the actions of his/her race team, family, or anyone signed in under that car.
- 2. Fighting, rough driving, and other acts of violence will not be tolerated. **This includes rough driving during caution/pace laps.** Penalties will be issued based on the severity of the incident; including, but not limited to: fines, suspension, or probation.
- 3. Havasu 95 Speedway has **zero tolerance** for profanity, discourteous gestures, or behavior deemed detrimental to the betterment of the sport.
- 4. No one is allowed to enter another competitor's pit area without their permission. If a driver/crew member is found in another competitor's pit area without explicit permission, the offending race team will be issued penalties based on the severity of the situation.
- 5. No driver or crew member may be under the influence of alcohol, drugs or any other controlled substances while competing at Havasu 95 Speedway. Anyone found to be under the influence during a race event will be suspended for a period of no less than six (6) months.
- 6. The first three (3) finishers in each A-Main will proceed directly from the track to the tech shed. Failure to do some will result in immediate disqualification.
- 7. Only three (3) crew members may accompany the driver in the tech area unless Chief Technical Inspector requests more crew members.

ON-TRACK INCIDENT PROCEDURES

During a race event, if a racecar is involved in an on-track incident, and/or is stopped on or near the racing surface, and is unable to continue to make forward progress, unless extenuating emergency circumstances exist within the racecar (i.e., fire/smoke in the car, etc.), the driver must take the following steps:

- 1. Shut off electrical power, and if driver is uninjured, lower window net.
- 2. **STAY IN THE CAR**. Do not loosen, disconnect, or remove any driver personal safety equipment until directed to do so by safety personnel or track officials.
- 3. After being directed to exit the racecar, the driver should proceed to either the ambulance or track safety vehicles or do as otherwise directed by safety personnel or track officials.
- 4. At no time should a driver or crew member(s) approach any portion of the racing surface or apron.
- 5. At no time should a driver or crew member(s) approach another moving vehicle.

All vehicles not involved in the incident, or vehicles that were involved but are able to continue afterwards, should slow down to a cautious speed and use extreme care as they approach an incident scene, and all vehicles must follow all directions given by safety personnel or track officials. Cars in line behind the safety car should not weave or otherwise stray from the line in the vicinity of the incident.

FAILURE TO OBEY THESE PROCEDURES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION!

Havasu 95 Speedway does not like having to disqualify or penalize drivers. Please follow these rules and have fun at the races!

Purpose of Form
