



WATERLESS BOAT RACE RULES

Revised: Dec. 18, 2017

DISCLAIMER

These rules are in effect as of December 18, 2017. This publication supersedes all previous HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY rules and rule updates.

HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY reserves the right to alter or amend the rules and regulations in the interest of safety, cost control, and/or fair competition. It is the responsibility of each competitor to read and understand the contents of these rules. If there is a disagreement or dispute regarding the meaning or application of these rules, the decision of the HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY Race Director shall prevail.

No expressed or implied warranty of safety shall result from publications of or compliance with these rules and/or regulations. The rules and/or regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY racing events and to establish minimum acceptable requirements for such events. These rules shall govern the condition of all events, and by participating in these events, all participants are deemed to have complied with these rules.

No pretense is made for having designed a foolproof set of rules and regulations. The spirit and intent of the rules is the standard by which HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY events will be governed. The HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY Race Director is authorized to decide if an equipment change or modification is an attempt to circumvent these rules. The HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY Race Director can and will disqualify a race car in violation of the spirit and intent of these rules. If this rulebook does not specifically state that you can alter, change, or otherwise modify something on your car, you should consider it a violation of these rules. No part is deemed to have been approved by HAVASU 95 SPEEDWAY by passing through prior technical inspections.

The Race Director shall be empowered to permit reasonable and appropriate deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any further restrictions that in his opinion do not alter the minimum acceptable requirements. No expressed or implied warranty of safety shall result from such alteration of specifications. Any interruption or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the Race Director. His/her decision is final.

These rules are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator or official. All participants, guest and crew members fully understand that racing is inherently dangerous and that they are exposed to risks of death or serious bodily injury. The participants, guest and crew members voluntarily assume these risks.

1. CAR

- A. Only small cars or pickup trucks may be used. No full-size trucks or vans allowed.
- B. Must remove all glass. Windshield or windscreen must be used for front window.
- C. All lights and trim must be removed from car.
- D. Extra bumper may be installed to front end.
- E. A bar must be welded in place from B-pillar to B-pillar, or door post to door post, so that the car can take a side impact without bucking in toward driver or passengers.
- F. Doors must be securely fastened closed, either with bolts, chains, or welds.
- G. Window nets are strongly recommended. If driving with passengers, window nets are recommended for their windows as well.
- H. Fire extinguisher must be installed to interior of car in reach of the driver.
- I. Seat belts are required. 5-point harnesses are recommended, but not required.

2. BOAT

- A. Boat must be made of fiberglass. NO steel or aluminum boats.
- B. Boat must be completely gutted. No seats, glass or interior components.
- C. Engine and rear transom must be removed.
- D. Boat must be towed in upright position facing forward. Boats cannot be upside down or backwards.
- E. Boat must be hooked to car with a chain or cable with minimum of 24 inches between car and boat. NO trailers.
- F. NO reinforcing of boat hulls.

3. DRIVERS (& PASSENGERS IF APPLICABLE)

- A. All occupants in car must wear a fire suit, helmet, neck brace or donut, gloves and thick-soled boots. Fire resistant shoes are recommended but not required.
